In general, Laudato Si' Plans are template planning materials that support the development of culture and processes to achieve full sustainability in the holistic spirit of integral ecology. You are warmly invited to use these plans in your institution, community, or family.

Laudato Si' Planning begins with discernment and reflection. Laudato Si' calls us to undergo an "ecological conversion," one that develops our awareness of the relationships between Creator, creation, and all our brothers and sisters. This ecological conversion is not something we experience once, but rather a continued enrichment of our spirits and a deepening of our understanding.

Our conversion naturally becomes action. The Laudato Si' Plans will suggest a list of approximately 10 to 15 actions for each of the Laudato Si' Goals. You are invited to choose which of the actions best suit your priorities and needs. You are the expert on your institution, community, or family, and you know which actions are best for you. Taken together, these actions represent a transformative journey in the holistic spirit of Laudato Si'.

You will be able to see the concrete difference that your actions are making by tracking your outcomes. In this way, you will be able to celebrate your progress, address areas of challenge, and join the universal human family in building a better future together.

Your journey will consist of several years, and must be completed in no more than seven years.
